ere's the low-down on the latest salon offerings designed to refresh your skin and body.

Treatment: Dermablading is a manual form of exfoliation, removing fine facial hair from around the neck and chin. Patients see immediate results in skin texture, appearance and circulation.

What to expect: A thorough cleanse by a trained nurse, followed by stroking across the skin with a sterile scalpel in a motion similar to shaving. You'll need about 40 minutes. Downtime: None. And despite common misconceptions, regrowth of dark or thicker hair is not a risk as Dermablading targets only the fine hair fibres known as the vellus.

Treatment: Dermal rolling, which is also known as skin needling, is used in the treatment of acne scarring, stretch marks, fine lines, enlarged pores and pigmentation.

What to expect: A small roller made of surgical needles is applied to the surface of the skin.

The needling stimulates the skin's supportive structure, encouraging a natural collagen renewal. It's ideal for people who cannot use laser therapy.

Downtime: Minimal to none with this 30-60 minute treatment.

Cost: From \$349 for face per treatment. For details, visit laserclinics.com.au.

Cryotherapy is a noninvasive, hypercooling treatment where your body is briefly – and safely – cooled to -140C for three minutes in a fine nitrogen-misted chamber.
Why: For cellulite reduction, skin rejuvenation, muscle recovery and repair.
What it feels like: Cold! Keep moving and the few minutes literally fly by. I felt more energetic for the rest of the day, I slept better that night
